



design! proclaims Odyssey: Stone Architecture & Design, a two decades old company which combines skilled hand-crafting along with the latest technology and equipments to create stone wonders. Their latest offering, the utterly stunning and exclusive Ishi-Kiri collection is one such initiative. Ishi-Kiri, is inspired by the traditional Japanese paper-folding art of Origami and can be utilized

for surfaces, sculptures and cascades. Ishi-Kiri exploits the pleats and creases (as in paper) in multi-dimensional forms to create dramatic installations. Crafted in pure white marble, this range takes a new step forward in the direction of customized back-lit surfaces, which were typically done in onyx. Though there are 18 beautiful designs in this collection, we particularly loved the Cho (with a butterfly in the

cocoon design), Fureku (resembling snowflakes), Puri-tsu (inspired by fine pleats), Rokkaku (the enclosed structure of a bee hive) and Taiyo (the sun)... all featured here. Also notable is the Reika (delicate floral patterns) and the wowinducing Suwaru (small circles carved into the stone in a swirl to create a 3D effect).
